## Sexual Misconduct in Housing

## Sexual misconduct in housing includes:

sexual assault, sexual harassment, and other unwelcomed sexual advances or behaviors, such as sexually suggestive comments or questions that make it hard to live and feel safe in your home.

Every person deserves to find and stay in housing without facing the threat of being sexually harassed by a landlord.

No one should be turned away or evicted from HUD assisted housing for choosing not to submit to sexual demands, advances, or inappropriate behavior.

## You have the right to be protected.

Together we can protect our communities from sexual predators and promote a safe and healthy housing environment for everyone.

If you, or someone you know has been a victim of sexual harassment, sexual assault, or sexual exploitation—even if the harassment occurred many years ago—please report it!
